Dear Parents, Guardians & Students,

Camp is an amazing time of building friendships, having fun, and most importantly growing closer to God. In order for your teenager to have the best camp experience possible, **there are a few things you need to know and do:**

- **Please be praying for: safety, spiritual growth, and unity!**
- **All money and Liability forms due no later than Wednesday, June 7.**
 - Please see below for balance due and anything else we still need from you.
 - Students must be paid in full to attend camp.
 - If students are participating in “work to earn camp program”, there are still days available to work.
- **Make sure your teenager has everything he or she needs for camp.**
 - See “what to bring and not to bring” on the next page enclosed.
 - Students will be responsible for their own luggage and belongings. Pack accordingly.
- **Send spending money for late night concessions, t-shirts, or a trip to Ivanhoe’s during camp.**
 - \$5 a day is sufficient but not required.
- **Help your teenager plan and bring outfits and supplies for our theme days:**
 - Team Spirit Day (our team color is **ORANGE!**) with a Disney Character style twist.
 - Restaurant Character Day
 - Meme Day
- **Please READ ALL the camp rules and information WITH YOUR TEENAGER (see next page)**
 - We do not anticipate any problems and have not had major problems in the past.
 - We do, however, reserve the right to send students home early if a major problem arises.
- **Please pay attention to the DRESS CODE.** (see next page)
 - Help your teenager pack accordingly.
 - We will ask your teenager to change their clothes if wearing something against code.
 - Here are some main things:
 - Leggings are not accepted unless shirt over reaches fingertips.
 - For swimming, Dark Shirts & Shorts are required at all times. Bathing suits can be worn under.
 - No tank tops, including dresses without sleeves.
- **Departure & Arrival**
 - Have your teenager at FaithChurch by **8:30am on Monday, June 19.**
 - Pick up your teenager at FaithChurch at **1:30pm on Friday, June 23.**
- **Contact Info**
 - Camp is at Lake Placid in Harford City, IN.
 - If you need to contact your teenager during camp **for emergencies only**, you may call the camp offices at 765.348.4503, 765.348.9922, or 765.348.4342.

 - **Students are not permitted to take cell phones or electronic devices to camp.**

SCHEDULE FOR TEEN CAMPS:

- Registration – Opens Monday at 10 a.m.
- Registration Closes – Noon
- Lunch served on Monday 12p – 1p
- Camp Dismissal – Friday at Noon

Campers who must leave early, except for emergencies, must make prior arrangements upon registering.

REGISTRATION - Send \$60 Registration Deposit, per camper (nonrefundable), or entire amount of tuition to:
re:mix student ministries at FaithChurch, Anderson
Make checks payable to
Faith Church.

AGE RESTRICTIONS: All teenagers between the ages of 12 – 19 (who are going into 7th grade through graduated from High School in 2017) are eligible to attend **re:mix** Teen Camp.

HEALTH & SAFETY – Trained First Aid Administrators, & Lifeguards, are provided for the safety of the campers. We provide secondary accidental (not illness) insurance, which covers each camper if not covered by other insurance. Emergency facilities are immediately available. All non-prescription and prescription drugs must be in their labeled original containers and turned in to the first aid administrator at registration. Medications such as Tylenol, ibuprofen, Benadryl, and anti-itch creams do not need to be sent with the camper.

CAMP RULES – There are camp rules firmly established to protect both the camper and the camp property. Upon registering for the camp, you are agreeing to abide by each rule. In the event a camper does not obey the rules, it is the option of the director to send the camper home (without a refund). If a camper is involved in the damaging of property, *the parent/guardian is financially responsible for the damage.*

APPAREL – for both guys and girls

Modesty please! Shorts, skirts, and shirts over leggings should be of modest length (at least to fingertips when arms are down at side is a good guide). NO TANK TOPS, halter tops, soffe shorts or excessively tight (no uncovered leggings) or otherwise inappropriate clothing will be permitted. Tops should cover shoulders, back, and chest for both daytime and evening. Clean dress or casual clothes should be worn for the evening services. Swimming Apparel: Shorts of modest length and dark cover up t-shirts over swimsuits are required at the swimming area. Parental assistance in planning is requested.
Dress code will be strictly enforced.

HEAD LICE - Teenagers with any signs of nits or lice will not be allowed to register and will be sent home. Please take care of this before coming to camp. Refunds will not be issued.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible, pen, notebook.
- Bedding (to fit twin bed) or sleeping bag & pillow
- Towels (2), washcloths, beach towel
- Casual clothes, recreation clothes, clothes for the evening services, gym shoes, sandals, light jacket, umbrella or rain gear, swimsuit with shorts & dark shirt for cover-up,
- Toiletries, and personal products.
- Watch or alarm clock
- Money for giving
- Spending money for the concession stand and camp sale items such as T-shirts, DVD, etc. (\$5 - \$10 per day is about average)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

These items will be removed from the camper's possession.

- electronic devices (games, ipods, etc.)
- Comic books, magazines, novels, etc.
- Matches, fireworks, cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, weapons, or any illegal substance or item.
- Please do not bring valuables!

Cell phones are discouraged and are at the discretion of each church whether they are allowed. They will not be allowed for use during activities/services. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

VISITING AND PHONE – It is recommended that parents refrain from visiting with, calling, or coming to the camp before the time of dismissal. The above practices usually promote homesickness, disrupt the schedule and cause other complications. **Mail is encouraged.** Parents may give mail to **re:mix** staff prior to camp departure or mail directly to camp (several days in advance).
